New Tools:

I am thrilled to have added the TOYO Pistol Grip cutters and the Silberschnitt Cut Running Pliers to our tool arsenal.

The **TOYO Pistol Grips** come with the narrow Pattern Head, which is designed to move more flexibly around a curved designed. Our TOYO Pencil grip scorer has the wider head which is designed to run against a straight edge.

The **Silberschnitt** Cut Running Pliers are quite simply the best running pliers I have ever seen. They are designed for stained glass.

I would not use them on ceramics. They are a serious investment, but well worth it to the glass-cutter.
